



Volunteer Benefits

Frost Science volunteers are eligible for the following benefits:

- Opportunity to meet others who share a passion for science
- Professional development opportunities
- Science communication and guest experience training
- Sneak peek of new exhibitions and programs
- Service award pins at hour/year milestones
- Invitations to regular volunteer gatherings, including volunteer recognition events
- Quarterly volunteer newsletter
- Community service hours for students
- A Frost Science uniform
- Access to the museum's Volunteer Training Lounge, including community lockers

After a Frost Science volunteer accumulates 50 hours, he or she will receive a one-year individual museum membership with associated benefits, including a 10% discount at the museum store and café. (Option available to upgrade to a Family Membership at a discounted rate.)

Volunteer Requirements

- Volunteers are public service ambassadors for Frost Science. Volunteers are expected to be friendly, courteous and represent the museum in a positive, professional and supportive manner at all times.
- A Level 2 background check (including fingerprinting) and drug screening are required for teens and adults (ages 16+). Frost Science covers the cost of these clearances.
- Commit to a minimum of 100 hours per year
- Volunteers will be placed on a weekly or biweekly schedule based on their availability and museum needs.
- Attend a basic volunteer training before the start of their commitment
- Wear a Frost Science uniform for the duration your shift.
- Volunteers will receive informal and formal evaluations from their assigned supervisor.
