













There are two restrooms on the first floor. Once is located near the wall with blue tile next to the Planetarium.

I can also visit the MeLa $\beta$  exhibition on this day.





There is a dance floor that lights up in this exhibition. Sometimes there is music playing.

At 8:45am I may go to a Planetarium show with my group. This will be like going to the movies. My group will need to leave strollers outside if possible.






I will enter the Planetarium preshow area and follow the directions of the staff to enter the Planetarium.


